ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Complete 16 NCAA Core Courses

- >2.3 GPA in core courses
- 16 NCAA Core Classes
- Complete 10 core courses before the 7th Semester
- Earn an SAT combined score or ACT sum score that matches your core course GPA on NCAA sliding scale

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

✓ How to plan your high school courses to meet the 16 core-course requirement:

✓ $4 \times 4 = 16$

- 4 English courses (one per year)
- 4 math courses (one per year)
- 4 science courses (one per year)
- social science (and/or additional) courses (one per year)
(But Paly requires 4 years of Social Studies)

✓ MUST COMPLETE 10 CORE COURSES PRIOR TO THE 7TH SEMESTER OF HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC CAREER TO BE A FULL QUALIFIER

✓ If looking to play at either the Division I or II level, registering with the eligibility center is important to do, USUALLY DURING THE sophomore year OF THE STUDENT ATHLETE

✓ \$80 One time fee

✓ NCAA rules require you to be registered with the NCAA Eligibility Center in order to be recruited, to go on an official visit, to receive an offer of FINANCIAL aid or to sign a National Letter of Intent, but it is not required for you to receive an academic evaluation before any of these.

DIVISION BREAKDOWN



Division i

- ✓ Larger student populations
- ✓ More revenue is generated by the athletic department (more scholarships given)
- ✓ Increased time demands of student athletes
- ✓ More television exposure on major networks



Division ii

- ✓ Emphasis on life balance; between athletics & academics
- ✓ Less revenue generation by athletic departments (less scholarships given)
- ✓ Fewer sports usually offered by the institution



Division iii

- ✓ Smaller student populations
- ✓ Academically driven institutions
- ✓ No “athletic scholarship” awarded
- ✓ Shortened seasons
- ✓ Less number of institutions, yet larger number of teams

SCHOLARSHIPS

- ✓ OVER \$2.7 BILLION DOLLARS GIVEN IN SCHOLARSHIPS BY THE NCAA SPREAD WITHIN THE 3 DIVISIONS
- ✓ 2% OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT ATHLETES RECEIVE A FULL ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP TO NCAA DIVISION 1
- ✓ DIVISION 1
 - may provide tuition and fees, room and board, books, and other expenses related to attendance at the school
- ✓ DIVISION 2
 - full scholarships cover tuition and fees, room, board and course-related books and supplies. Most student- athletes who receive athletics scholarships receive an amount covering a portion of these costs
- ✓ SINGLE YEAR OR MULTI YEAR: SCHOLARSHIPS ARE RENEWED ANNUALLY, UNLESS THERE IS AN AGREEMENT ON A MULTIYEAR SCHOLARSHIP THAT IS DISCUSSED BETWEEN COACH & STUDENT-ATHLETE
- ✓ PERCENTAGE: FULL SCHOLARSHIP (100%) OR PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1%-99%)

RECRUITING TERMS

✓ Financial aid

- Any money you receive from a college or another source, such as outside loans or grants. Financial aid may be based on athletics ability, FINANCIAL need or academic achievement.

✓ Official visit

- ✓ Must register with NCAA Eligibility Center
- ✓ College can pay for transportation to and from the college, lodging and meals (Division I allows for up to three meals per day) for you and your parents or guardians, as well as reasonable entertainment expenses including three tickets to a Division I home sports event or RECEIVE tickets to a Division II home sports event. Before a college may invite you on an of

✓ Unofficial Visit

✓ Walk-on

- Someone typically recruited by a school to participate in sports but does not receive athletic scholarship from the school, but becomes a member of one of the school's athletics teams.

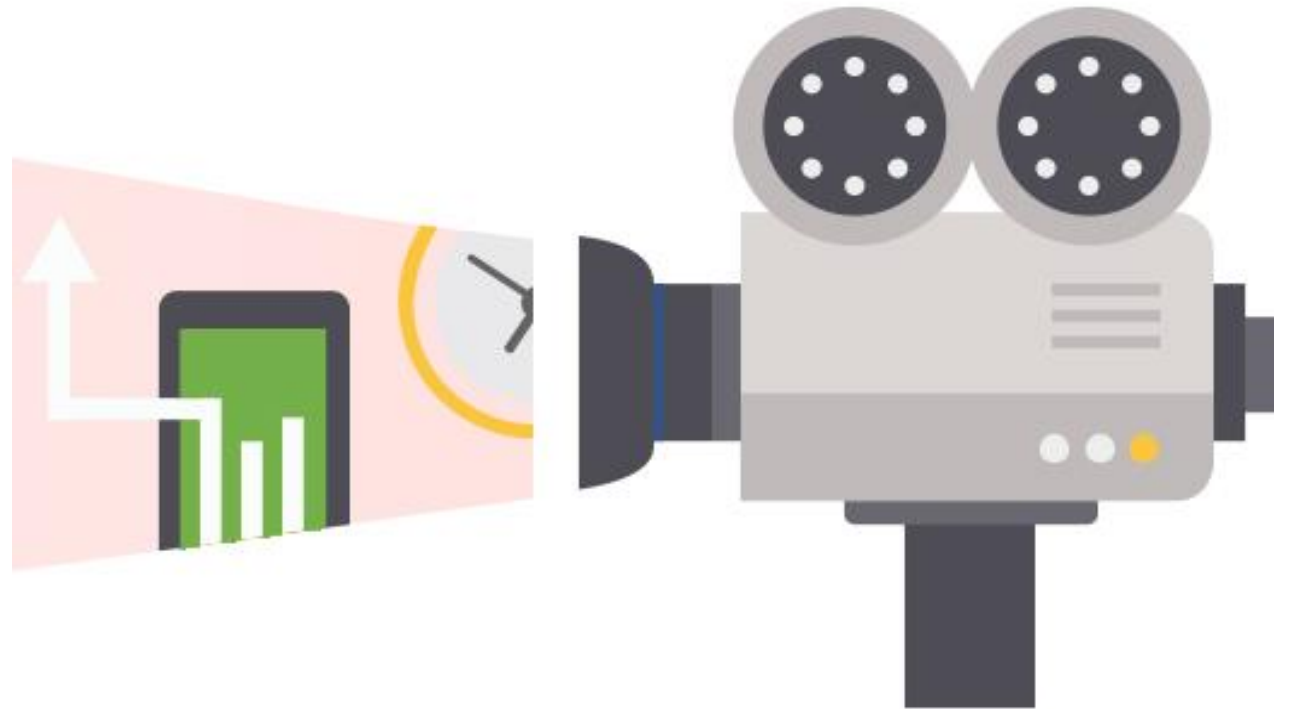


